## 1. Introduction

This document provides the submission and formatting instructions for the camera-ready version of the papers accepted for publication in the proceedings of the 41st Annual IEEE/ACM International Symposium on Computer Architecture, 2014 [1].

## 2. Preparation Instructions

### 2.1. Paper Formatting

All submissions should contain a maximum of 12 pages of single-spaced two-column text. You cannot purchase extra pages. If you are using  $\text{\LaTeX}$  to typeset your paper, then we suggest using the template available at the ISCA-41 website: <http://cag.engr.uconn.edu/isca2014>. If you are using a different software package to typeset your paper, then please adhere to the guidelines in Table 1.

**Do NOT include page numbers in the final version.**

### 2.2. Content

**Author List.** Please include the names of all authors along with their affiliation and email ID. Please refer to the sample author block in this document.

**Figures and Tables.** Ensure that the figures and tables are legible. Please also ensure that you refer to your figures in the main text. Many readers print the papers in gray-scale. Therefore, if you use colors for your figures, ensure that the different colors are distinguishable in gray-scale.

**Main Body.** Avoid bad page or column breaks in your main text, i.e., last line of a paragraph at the top of a column or first line of a paragraph at the end of a column. If you begin a new section or sub-section near the end of a column, ensure that you have at least 2 lines of body text on the same column.

### 2.3. Copyright Notice

All papers must have a copyright notice on the lower-left corner of the first page. For papers in which all authors are employed by the US government, the copyright notice is: **U.S. Government work not protected by U.S. copyright.** For papers in which all authors are employed by a Crown government (UK, Canada, and Australia), the copyright notice is: **978-1-4799-4394-4/14/\$31.00 © 2014 Crown.** For all other papers the copyright notice is **978-1-4799-4394-4/14/\$31.00 © 2014 IEEE.**

## 3. Submission Instructions

Complete the steps specified below to submit your paper.

1. Visit <http://www.pdf-express.org/plus/>.
2. Register for an account with Conference ID: **32457XP**.
3. Login using your newly created account.
4. Click on **Create New Title**.
5. Click on **Submit File for Checking or Converting**.
6. Click **Browse**, select your file, then click **Upload File**.
7. Wait for email confirmation from IEEE that your document is IEEE Xplore compliant.
8. Once your document is approved, click on **Approve for Collection** and follow the remaining steps for final submission.
9. Email your signed IEEE copyright form to Eric Chung (erchung@microsoft.com).

**The deadline for submitting the final paper and signing the copyright release is 11:00pm Pacific Daylight Time (PDT) April 17, 2014.**
