

# ISCA 2015 Camera-Ready Instructions

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## Abstract

*This document contains instructions and formatting guidelines for authors submitting the camera-ready version of their papers accepted to ISCA 2015.*

## 1. Instructions

### 1.1. Page Limits

- All submissions should contain a maximum of 13 pages, including two-column body text, figures, tables, and references.
- Up to 11 body pages are free. Pages containing ANY non-reference material will be counted as a body page. Pages containing only references are always free.
- Up to 2 additional body pages can be purchased for 100 USD per page, to be submitted during registration.

### 1.2. Formatting

When typesetting your paper, please follow the guidelines listed in Table 1. Do NOT include page numbers in the final manuscript.

Make sure to include the names of all authors along with their affiliation and email ID. Please refer to the sample author block in this document.

Ensure that the figures and tables are legible. Please also ensure that you refer to your figures in the main text. Many readers print the papers in gray-scale. Therefore, if you use colors for your figures, ensure that the different colors are distinguishable in gray-scale.

Avoid bad page or column breaks in your main text—i.e., last line of a paragraph at the top of a column or first line of a paragraph at the end of a column. If you begin a new section or sub-section near the end of a column, ensure that you have at least 2 lines of body text on the same column.

### 1.3. Copyright Notice

The following ACM Copyright Paragraph must appear on the first page of each paper: *Permission to make digital or hard*

## 2. Submission Instructions

- Authors will be individually contacted by ACM with instructions on submitting the rights management form. The system will also provide rights management text and a bibliographic strip to appear underneath the copyright notice. Authors are responsible for updating their manuscripts with this information.
- Submit the finalized PDF of your paper labeled as follows: ISCA15\_ "Lead Author".pdf to [erchung@microsoft.com](mailto:erchung@microsoft.com) with the conference name and the number of your submission in the subject line (e.g., ISCA15 - # - Camera Ready).
- **The deadline for submitting the final paper and ACM electronic copyright forms is 11:59pm Pacific Daylight Time (PDT) April 20, 2015.**
